TUITION WAIVER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Waivers can be given to:
 - graduate assistants (occupation codes M9182, M9184, N9185, W9185, Z9185),
 - fellowship holders, and
 - **“allowable exceptions”** who are students enrolled for the minimum hours during each semester and **DO NOT** have a qualifying appointment. This exception is by school/college discretion AND must have the applicable dean’s approval.
2. **Waivers are canceled if the student withdraws from the University, drops below the required academic load, or terminates the assistantship or fellowship. Waivers will be revoked if any University authority terminates the assistantship upon which the waiver is based or cancels the student's enrollment. Waivers will not cover any dropped classes.**
3. **The student will be responsible for any fees assessed. See fee schedule below.**
4. If a student officially withdraws from the university, and the petition is approved, a refund can only be provided if the refund or withdrawal request is submitted within six months after the end of the semester in which the withdrawal occurred. If financial aid is received by the student during the term in which the refund is granted, state and federal regulations may require that the refund be returned to the aid source.

5. Fall and Spring Graduate Assistants must earn at least \$1500 per term. Graduate fellowship holders must receive at least \$3150 for Fall term and \$3150 for Spring term through FSU. Summer requirements should be verified with the graduate department.
6. Although a 19 week appointment is preferred, a minimum of 15 weeks is required for the Fall and Spring terms. The minimum appointment must be at least 25% FTE or greater. Check with your department on Summer requirements.
7. The required academic load for a graduate assistant is nine (9) hours. Fellows are required to carry twelve (12) hours. Exceptions must be approved by the Dean of Graduate Studies.
8. Waivers can cover only courses related to the student's academic degree. Waivers cannot be used for Sponsored Institute courses through APPS.

If you have applied to the FSU Office of Financial Aid for financial assistance, you must contact that office so they may discuss how accepting this award impacts other sources of financial aid. Our department has notified the Office of Financial Aid of this award.
